

FORSYTH COUNTY FAMILY HAVEN PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

Welcome to the Forsyth County Family Haven website (“Website”). Forsyth County Family Haven, Inc. (“Family Haven” “we,” “us” or “our”) provides this Website to you for your convenience and in order to provide you the ability to:

- Access information about our organization, purpose and activities;
- Join our mailing list
- Volunteer for certain opportunities;
- Identify certain career opportunities with us; and
- Make charitable donations to us via our third-party provider.

Your access to this Website is subject to your agreement with the Terms and Conditions, including these privacy policy terms (“Privacy Policy”). The Terms and Conditions together with this Privacy Policy constitute the agreement between you and Family Haven regarding use of this Website (“Agreement”). Your use of any third-party websites is subject to the applicable terms and conditions, privacy policies and other terms and conditions of each individual third-party website with regard to the activities and information you share.

Our privacy philosophy is based on the concept of fair information practices. This means we provide you with notice of how we manage and collect information so that you can have a more informed understanding of how we operate. Applicability of this Privacy Policy; Third Party Sites

This Privacy Policy sets forth the privacy practices of Family Haven.

The Website may contain links to, or be accessed through links on, websites managed and operated by or on behalf of third-party entities. Some pages of the Website may also contain embedded content and application widgets provided by third-party websites (collectively, “Widget Applications”), including without limitation, Widget Applications that allow syndication of content and interaction with social media websites such as PayPal and Facebook. These third-party website operators are separate and independent entities, and are not agents of Family Haven. Family Haven does not have control over such third-party websites, even if portions of their syndicated content may appear on the Website as a result of our use of a Widget Application. Notice of Information Collected

Family Haven currently only collects limited personally identifiable information that you provide to us, including information you provide when you make a donation, join our mailing list or otherwise. You are not required to provide personally identifiable information to visit this Website.

Non-Personally Identifiable Information

We may collect non-personally identifiable information, which is automatically collected by the Website by us or through use of a third-party analytics vendor, as explained below.

Analytics

We may ourselves, or through various third party vendors, collect, track and analyze data regarding Website usage and trends. Such information may include your geographic location based on your IP address and other location-based data.

Use of Information Collected

Personal Information

We use the personal information you provide to us primarily in relation to the purpose provided. For example, we may use information you provide on a volunteer application to make a decision on the application or contact you. Additionally, we may use information you provide when making a donation to acknowledge your donation or send you a tax letter relating to such donation.

If you join our mailing list, we may use information we collect to send you news and information about our Website and services and to communicate with you about services, promotions, and other items offered by us. You may opt out of receiving promotional emails from Family Haven by following the instructions in those emails. If you opt out, we may still send you non-promotional communications, such as messages about our ongoing relations.

Non-Personal Information

We may use non-personal information about you to improve and personalize the Website. The non-personal information we collect may be used in the aggregate to create summary statistics that help us analyze website usage trends, assess what information is of most and least importance, determine technical design specifications, arrange the Website in the most user-friendly way, and identify system performance or problem areas.

Other Use and Ownership

We reserve the right to share your information collected from this Website with third parties if required to do so by law or if we believe such action is necessary in order to: (a) conform with the requirements of the law or to comply with legal process served upon us; (b) protect or defend our legal rights or property, or that of another customer or user; or (c) investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, or violations of the terms and conditions of using this Website.

Important Note Regarding Children

The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) was created to protect children under the age of thirteen (13) from unsuspecting acts or practices in conjunction with collecting, using,

and disclosing any information about them. Our Website is not intended for anyone under the age of 18. If you are a parent or guardian and believe that your child under 13 has provided personal information to us, please contact us so that we can delete the child's information. The Website will never knowingly accept, collect, maintain or use any information from a child under the age of thirteen (13).
